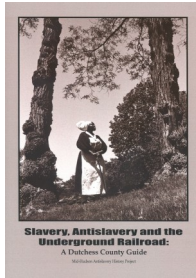

Participants set their own goal, work to achieve it over the course of 9 weeks and upon completion receive a certificate which they can pick up 8/9-9/3.

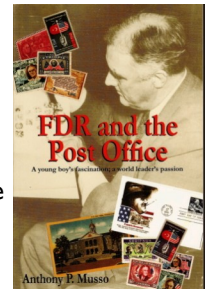
## SLAVERY, ANTI-SLAVERY & THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD IN DUTCHESS COUNTY

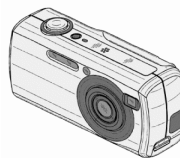
