for children ages 4-9

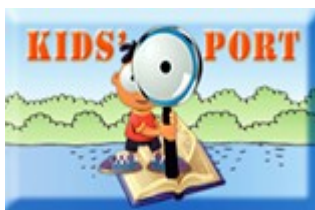

Development Check Up @ LaGrange Library

It's natural to measure your child's height and weight, but what about your child's development? The LaGrange Library, Astor Early Childhood Programs & United Way of Dutchess County are offering a FREE service to parents, grandparents and caregivers with children ages 4 months to 5 years to measure your child's growth and success. Specially trained Parent Educators will help you complete a brief questionnaire about your child's development. You'll review your child's communication, gross motor skills, fine motor skills, problem solving and personal/social. Immediate results will let you know where your child is excelling and where you can step in and help. To schedule your child's Development Check Up call 2-1-1. Limited spaces available; sign up early to secure your spot.
