

Welcome to your library

Library Cards

All residents of the Town of LaGrange can get a library card for free. You can apply online or in the Library. Adults are required to provide photo id and printed proof of residence. Children under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian present to co-sign at the time a card is issued. Your library card allows you to borrow and return materials at any of the 66 libraries in the Mid-Hudson Library System (MHLS), which includes Dutchess, Putnam, Ulster, Columbia and Greene Counties. There's a \$1 charge to replace a library card.

Borrowing Items

You must present your library card in order to check out items.

Borrowing Limits

- 25 LaGrange Library items per library card
- 5 media items, included as part of the 25 item limit, per library card (i.e. DVDs, Blu-rays, Music CDs, Wii, Xbox 360, Software)
- 3 books per non-fiction subject per family

Patrons with a temporary card have a limit of 5 items per library card, 2 of which can be media, for the first 6 months from when the new card was issued or registering after a time lapse.

Renewing Items

Items may be renewed 2 times, if no one is waiting for them and can be done online, by phone or in person.

Returning Items

Items may be returned at LaGrange Library or any library in the Mid-Hudson Library System (MHLS), which includes the libraries in Dutchess, Putnam, Ulster, Columbia and Green Counties. We also offer an outside book/media drop box available 24/7. Use it to return any library materials, including both book and media items.

Overdue Fine Schedule

The maximum fine is \$10 per item, excluding Museum Passes.

If you owe \$10 or more in fines, your library privileges will be suspended at all Mid-Hudson Library System libraries.

You will be sent an overdue notice for items that are 2 weeks overdue. If the items aren't returned after 1 month, you will receive a bill for the replacement cost of the items and your library privileges will be suspended until the charges are paid. Accounts owing \$25 or more in unreturned items and fines will be referred to a collection agency and will incur a \$10 fee upon referral.

Your Library Account

- Access your library account using your barcode and PIN. If this is your first time logging in, you'll need to create a PIN using 4-8 letters or numbers. You'll be asked to re-enter it to confirm.
- Search the online catalog for item listings at all 66 member libraries in the Mid-Hudson Library System.
- Place reserves on items and have them delivered at a library that's convenient for you. When your items arrive you'll be notified by email or phone call and have 7 days to pick them up.
- Check your account status
- Renew your items
- Pay fines and charges
- Search online magazine and newspaper databases
- Access eResources such as Consumer Reports, Mango Languages, Chilton Auto Repair, career and job information, homework help, TumbleBook Library, Book Club in a Bag and more
- Download eBooks and audiobooks with OverDrive
